- 4.1 Presentation of Three Model Comprehensive Re-opening Plans Ms. Kuehn presented the Charting the Course Together to Re-Open School Preliminary Plan, which included the following:

The Committee made comments and asked questions. The community then asked questions thru Chat. Mr. Twombly recommended having additional meetings on the books in case we need to pivot. Dr. Martin Iser, doctor for the Hull Public Schools, said that the preliminary plan is an excellent plan to keep everyone safe, with the 6 feet of separation at the Jacobs School and hybrid at the others to keep the 6 feet there. He said that if it were his choice he would do hybrid.

Brian Mullin, HTA co-president, read a statement, saying the teacher want to be fully remote learning for a time then hybrid when time is right.

The Committee members discussed going remote or hybrid. There was a lot of discussion on both sides. The Committee recognizes the fluidity of the situation and biweekly meetings to discuss its effectiveness are likely.
