4.1 NESDEC Superintendent Search – School Committee will be providing input into Superintendent Profile.

Dr. Frieswyk, NESDEC consultant for superintendent search told the Committee she had a productive day of focus groups. She said she felt welcomed at the three schools and she thanked everyone who participated. Dr. Frieswyk said she asked participants to answer the same two guiding questions, which were “What are the qualities, characteristics, skills, knowledge and experiences you desire in a new Superintendent of Schools” and “What do you see as the pressing tasks and challenges ahead for him or her in year one?” She went through the Draft Superintendent Search Successful Candidate Profile page by page and section by section and got feedback from School Committee members. School Committee members voiced their own answers to her questions. Brian Mullin, HTA co-president passed out his own survey that 50% of his membership completed. Dr. Frieswyk said she would compile the School Committee additions and the survey results after the survey closes tomorrow at 2:00 pm. She would then sent the draft to Ms. Conley, who would disseminate it to School Committee members for their review. Ms. Conley asked School Committee members to then review it independently and let her know their thoughts. Ms. Conley also said she has been compiling a list of potential screening committee members and thinks it is well distributed among our stakeholders. She will reach back out to those who volunteered to make sure they are available on November 20, December 4 and the week of December 11-15. She will give people a chance to contact her before the end of day on Sunday if interested. Dr. Frieswyk encouraged her not to go over the 12 members. At the end of the meeting Mr. Twombly recognized community member, Jacky Kilroe, who said she wanted to fill out the survey and be on the search committee. Mr. Twombly told her what to do for these things to happen.
