## 7.2 School Choice

Each year, prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, school districts must vote on whether or not to participate in school choice. Dr. Tyrell said that she did not think school choice makes sense for the Hull Public Schools at this time and recommended not participating. Dr. Tyrell also mentioned that currently, no towns on the south shore participate in school choice.

Mr. Hipp stated that he recommended looking further into School Choice in the past but given the towns desire to look into school consolidation he now is not the time. He stated that in the future if Hull participated in School Choice some of our immediate neighbors might do the same. Ms. Peters agreed and added that a subcommittee could be formed to look into it.
