Dave Degennaro informed the board of changes to the budget since developing it and that there will be continuous changes, but as always, the school department will stay within its means. Some of the changes included, votech move ins, increase in out-of-district tuitions and transportation,

lower enrollment, adding a behavior program at the middle school and building maintenance. He then highlighted some of the great things happening at the Hull Public Schools. The School Department is pleased to be at the Town Managers recommended number, reflecting a level services budget.
