Below, please find instructions on registering for MPY's professional development programs and applying for Professional Development Point (PDPs) certificates and Continuing Education Units (CEU) certificates.

REGISTRATION

- To register, please log in to MPY's website (www.mpyinc.org) using your district's Username and Password.
- Registration is required for each individual webinar, whether viewed "live" or recorded.
- Registration for **each event** must be completed on MPY's website.
- If a webinar has multiple sessions, you must register for each individual session to *be eligible to apply for PDPs and CEUs*.
- Registration for all MPY programs will close one business day before the scheduled event.

VIEWING RECORDED WEBINARS

- To help accommodate members' demanding schedules, MPY will continue to make the recorded webinar available for 72 hours following the live webinar.
- Following each webinar, MPY will email registered participants a link to view the recorded webinar.
- The link to each recorded webinar will be active for 72 hours. Once the viewing period has expired, MPY cannot re-share the link.

APPLYING FOR PDPs/CEUs:

- Professional Development Points (PDPs) are offered through the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and are awarded for all MPY professional development webinars. PDPs are issued to members who have attended a minimum of 10 hours of training.

- Continuing Education Units (CEUs) may be awarded upon approval by the National Association of Social Workers (NASW) and the Massachusetts Mental Health Counselors Association, Inc. (MaMHCA).
- PDP and CEU Request Forms and Evaluations will be made available to registered participants following the live webinar.
- Attendees may apply for PDPs/CEUs whether they view the webinar "live" or view the recorded webinar within 72 hours.
- PDPs and CEUs will only be issued to participants who have attended the webinar(s) and submitted the appropriate paperwork.
- Following each webinar, MPY will email registered participants a link to Cert Central. To receive a CEU certificate, participants will need to enter the required information in Cert Central's website.
- After completing 10 hours of professional development, registered participants will be emailed a link to Cert Central. To receive a PDP certificate, registrants will need to enter the required information in Cert Central's website.
