A Note from the Principal

This week, students in grades 3-6 participated in an anonymous 5-10 minute survey to help us better understand their perceptions and feelings about the learning environment at the Jacobs School. The survey, designed by School Social Worker Dr. Rosenplanter, will inform staff and administrators on student insights into three dimensions of our school climate: engagement, safety, and environment. (We plan to obtain feedback from our younger students in a more age-appropriate manner.) Staff from each grade level will meet with Dr. Rosenplanter on Monday to review the surveyed data and implement necessary adjustments to our practices to best meet the needs of our students. In March we will assess our progress and make further adjustments, if needed. Fostering an environment where every student feels safe and heard is a top priority for all of us at the Jacobs School. Providing students with a voice will contribute positively to that mission.

Since the beginning of January, the Hull High School girls basketball team has been working with Jacobs students on a weekly basis as part of the Lady Pirate Readers program. The goal of this program is not only to promote the love of basketball and encourage young students to attend the games, but also to demonstrate what it looks like to be a successful high school student athlete. The student athletes and the Jacobs students have had a blast getting to know each other!
