A Note from the Principal


Yesterday afternoon staff attended a virtual orientation for a new program we are implementing next week called **Raising** Multicultural Kids (RMK). RMK is an educational-based nonprofit organization that focuses on cultivating racial and cultural competence in schools. The mission of this program is "to provide individuals with a multicultural mindset, which celebrates differences and fosters the skills and tools necessary to take action on issues of equity." The goal of this program "is to have diverse leaders in the classroom as windows for white students to experience and understand other cultures; and mirrors for black and brown students to reflect on who they are in order to build their own identity." These student leaders are in college pursuing careers in education.

One of our school improvement objectives is to promote a school environment characterized by tolerance, respect, and safety.
