Last week, students in grades 3-6 shared valuable feedback on the Jacobs learning environment, guiding teachers in identifying areas of strength or needed improvement.

Beginning this week, students in grades K-2 will have the same

opportunity during a quick one minute, one-to-one check-in with our social workers. When asked simple questions like, "Is there an adult at my school who will help me if I need it?" students will respond by using a thumbs up or thumbs down. Our intention is to ensure every student is heard and feels safe, creating the optimal environment for growth and learning.

Next week, grades 4-6 will compete against each other in an adopted Memorial School tradition called Penny Wars. The competition will raise money to help cover the cost of the 6th grade overnight trip to Nature's Classroom. Students are encouraged to bring loose change from home to participate in the game. Each morning, students will contribute pennies and bills towards their own grade level fund to earn positive points. In addition, they will strategize to contribute silver coins to sabotage the other grades. Silver coins will be calculated as negative points that take away from a grade's total. The grade level with the highest point value on Friday will earn ice cream treats and bragging rights!

The first round of interviews for the upper school assistant principal will take place this afternoon. It is my hope that a decision will be made by the Friday before February break.
