Thank you for the appreciation demonstrated with the treats, flowers, and notes last week to all the staff during Teacher Appreciation Week. We are grateful for all the support and kindness bestowed upon our staff.

Last week our kindergarten students had two visitors accompanied by their therapy dogs to teach them about dog safety. The Plymouth County Extension 4-H Program sponsored this free program.

Grade 5 planted salad mix in our raised beds. First, the fifth graders calculated the perimeter and area of our garden space and determined there are 32 square feet in each bed. Next, they divided the beds into squarefoot plots and planted seeds. Lastly, they looked at the compost, talked about decomposition, and decided our school needs a pitchfork to turn the compost! The fifthgraders planted seeds and determined that based on 30 days to harvest, we should be able to have a 5thgrade salad-fest on or around June 10!

Today, our 3-5 graders had a concert from the Hull High School Band. Mr. Ian Barkon, the high school music teacher, brought the band to perform and encourage Jacobs students to think about playing a musical instrument and participating in the band as they get older. I hope in the next year or two we can begin the process of reintroducing a band program for our fourth and fifth-grade students.
