A Few Spring/Summer Reminders

- **Sun Safety:** The number one rule is PREVENTION! Use sunscreen daily and reapply every 2 hours while outdoors. Seek the shade, especially between 10am and 4pm. Wear a hat as well as UV blocking sunglasses.
- Water, Water, Water.... It's always important to keep our bodies hydrated, but especially so during the warmer months. Please be sure to send your child to school with a water bottle. We do have a hydration station where students can refill their water bottles as needed throughout the day.
- *Ticks!* While most tick bites are harmless and don't require medical attention, some ticks (like the deer tick, wood tick and others) can carry harmful germs and cause disease. Please check your child's body for ticks, including their scalp and back. If a tick is found please follow these instructions:
- Remove the tick with tweezers
- Pull steadily outward and away from the skin, do not twist or jerk the tick
- Protect your fingers and hand with a tissue, or glove
- Apply alcohol or disinfectant to area after tick removal
- Place tick in jar of alcohol and keep for identification
- Wash hands with soap and water
- Observe the site for signs of a rash for at least a month
