### Ms. Keegan's Spring/Summer Reminders:

**Ticks:** While most tick bites are harmless and don't require medical attention, some ticks (like the deer tick, wood tick and others) can carry harmful germs and cause disease. Please check your child's body for ticks, including their head and back.



**Sun Safety:** The Number One Rule is "PREVENTION!" Use sunscreen daily and reapply every 2 hours while outdoors. Seek the shade, especially between 10 and 4 pm. Wear a hat as well as UV blocking sunglasses.

**Water, Water, Water....** It's always important to keep our bodies hydrated, but especially so during the warmer months. Please be sure to send your child in with a water bottle. We do have a hydration station where students can refill their water bottle as needed throughout the day.



**Footwear Flop:** As much as I love flip flops, they are not the best footwear for school/recess activities. Please encourage your child to wear sneakers to school to avoid injury.
