A Note from the Principal

Day two is in the books! It had been 187 days since we were last in the Jacobs School with our students. We have captured some moments in pictures to give you an idea of what in-person looks like this year.

The arrival today took 25 minutes—a huge improvement from yesterday! The following changes were made to decrease the drop-off time:

- Buses started their routes earlier and arrived at the school on time.
- Students exited three cars at a time and walked into the building.
- Students got their first squirt of hand sanitizer as they entered the building rather than at their vehicle.

It is critical that students use the vehicle's passenger side door to exit safely to the sidewalk, and never step into potential traffic from the driver's side of the car. Also, please remember that masks must be worn while waiting at bus stops.

Dismissal may have been a complete bottleneck yesterday, but today there was significant improvement. We shaved 30 minutes off the time! We expect to do even better in the days to come as we identify issues and fine-tune our operation. For instance, starting tomorrow walkers will be dismissed from the schoolyard at the iron gate to the playground.
