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Course Overview:

Students will complete their study of the major elements of Spanish grammar. Readings, composition writing and discussion topics will be used to enhance student fluency and self-expression. Students explore the literary, artistic and cultural heritage of Spain and Latin America in greater depth.

Prerequisite: Successful completion of Level II Spanish.

Course Objectives:

- Students will demonstrate knowledge of world cultures.
- Students will be a competent problem solver.
- Students will use technology.
- Students will use the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing.
- Students will gain knowledge and understanding of other cultures.
- Students will develop insight into the nature of language and culture by comparing their own language and culture with another.
- Students will make connections with other subject areas and acquire information.

Course Content:

- Vocabulary: Train, food and beverages, holidays, technology, hotel and hostel, the city and the country.
- Grammar: Present tense, reflexive verbs, preterit tense, direct and indirect object pronouns, preterite tense, imperfect tense, present perfect tense and the future tense.
- Verb forms: A variety of regular and irregular verbs.
- Culture: Discuss train trips, restaurants in Spain and Latin America, Hispanic holidays, technology in the Hispanic countries, hotel stays in Latin America and Spain, compare and contrast a hotel and a hostel, and discuss the differences between the city and the country in Latin America. We will explore the culture of Spain and Latin America with an emphasis on Puerto Rico.
