#### What is Waves?

Waves is a flexible, therapeutic, inclusion program. Our classroom is an extension of the Team Based Learning Program in the Hull Public Schools. The program provides academic instruction in the regular education setting, as well as in a self-contained classroom. The vision for the Waves is to provide a challenging academic program in a highly individualized and supportive environment. This program serves students with social, emotional, academic, and self-regulatory challenges. Students will develop a variety of skills to facilitate the successful transition into the general education curriculum.

## **Classroom Rules and Expectations:**
