Jacobs Elementary

Increased Cohorts from 3 to 4 per Grade Level*

- Kindergarten – 10 and under
- Grade 1 – 11 and under
- Grade 2 – 11 and under
- Grade 3 – 13 and under
- Grade 4 – 12 and under
- Grade 5 – 10 and under

*Social Distancing at 6 feet

Class Size

Social Distancing at 6 Feet

- Memorial School

- Class size by cohort
- Grade 6 class size are 10 or under
- Grade 7 class sizes are 10 or under
- Grade 8 class sizes are 8 or under

- Hull High School

- Most classes 5-10 students
- Largest class 17 students taught in a larger space
- Second largest 13-14
- Some smaller than average with only 2 or 3

HVAC

- Independent HVAC Engineer in agreement with HTA – BLW Engineers
- Professionally cleaned exhaust vents
- Partnering with Chief Russo to take CO2 levels in classrooms
- Eleven (11) outside air changes per hour
- 50% minimum outside air setting
- Increase occupancy schedules
- Filter changes - MERV 5 to MERV 8
- Custodians & teachers daily routine to check univents

Health & Safety

- Health and Safety protocols in place consistent with Department of Secondary and Elementary Education (DESE) and Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- Consultation with Manet Community Health Center infectious disease doctor, Dr. Yang
- Full time nurse in each building
- All staff trained on personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Consistent collaboration with Hull Board of Health

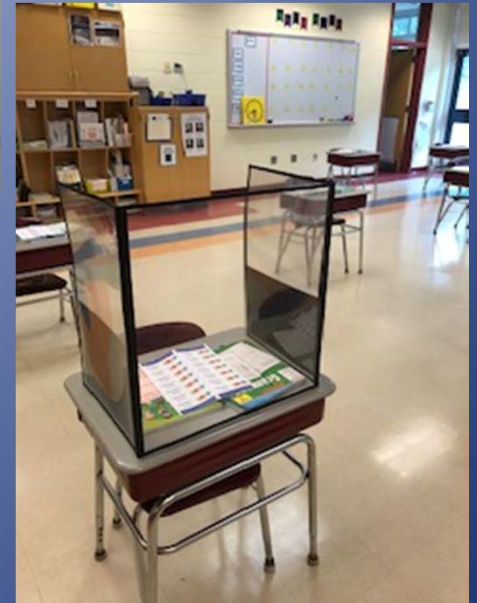
Personal Protective Equipment

- Gowns
- Masks
- Disposable gloves
- Face shields
- Disinfectant
- Paper towels
- Hand sanitizer
- Hand soap
- Paper cups
- Paper bags



Health & Safety

- Plexiglass shields
- Portable desk shields for educators and paraprofessionals
- Desk shields for kindergarten and grade one



Health & Safety

All employees and students will be required to use hand sanitizer or wash hands upon:

- Entering the building
- Before and after meals
- After bathroom use
- After coughing or sneezing
- End of school day



Important Measures for Safety

- Social distancing keep 6 feet apart
- Wearing masks/face coverings
- Staying home when sick



Cleaning/Disinfecting our Schools

- Follow Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines
- Training on proper cleaning/disinfecting techniques
 - EPA-registered disinfectants used
 - Cordless electrostatic handheld sprayers
 - Disinfecting logs utilized and posted
 - Supply of PPE equipment and disinfectant
 - Will hire additional custodial staff for midday

- Traffic flow

- Assigned seats
- Sit facing forward
- No sharing of materials
