### Art in Nature

**weeks offered: 6/13, 7/18, 8/15**

Children will use and learn different art forms while exploring the natural beauty of Holly Hill Farm.

### Adventure on the Farm

**weeks offered: 6/20, 7/5, 8/1**

Children will use compasses, practice basic survival skills, build shelters, quest, and more during this adventurous week.

### Growing Citizen Scientists

**weeks offered: 6/27, 8/22**

Children will learn how to be citizen scientists and contribute to ecological and conservation work through observation and data collection while also studying how nature can inspire and inform our decisions.

### Growing Drama on the Farm

**2 week program: 8/1-8/12**

During this two-week program, children will learn what it takes to write, direct, design, and act in a play.

Children will be given the opportunity to help solve problems and meet the physical, educational, ecological, and spiritual needs of the farm and the larger farm community.

### Growing a Civilization

**Week offered: 7/11**

Children will travel back in time before all of their basic needs were provided for them and will learn how to use what the natural world provides to meet those needs.

### Farming

**Week offered 6/6, 8/8**

Help the farm start its day with growing, planting, weeding and harvesting. We will take on a variety of tasks that need to be completed, and explore habitats around us!
