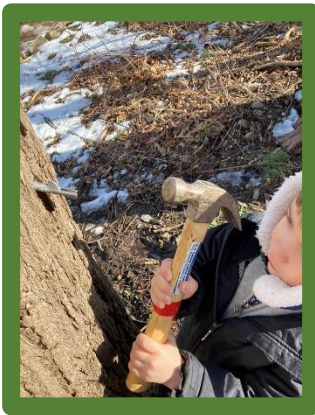


Morning Drop-off Programs Afterschool Programs

Outdoor Exploration & Creation

*Mondays: Ages 10-14
Tuesdays: Ages 6-9*

Children will explore and create within the secret areas around the farm, including woods, meadows and Ice Pond. Each outing they will learn to navigate, observe and create within these winter settings. Children may be using compasses, building full-size fairy homes, tracking animals, and possibly create a winter civilization!

Winter STEAM Wednesdays: Ages 10-14

*Wednesdays: Ages 10+
Thursdays: Ages 6-9*

Based on the many science themes of winter, children will experiment, engineer, solve problems, create art, write poems and stories, and more. Some of these themes may include formation of ice & snow, maple sugaring, winter farming, and animal shelters and habits.



Home School Programming
